4. **NEW:** Completion of Georgia Educator Ethics – Program Entry (350). Once test takers complete this test, they can print a “Certificate of Completion.”
5. A grade of “C” or higher in Essential Skills core and in EDUC 2110.
6. A grade point average of no less than 2.50 (includes all GSU and all transfer credit).
7. **For Art Education Applicants Only:**
Your required portfolio submission for AE 4200, plus your level of performance in AE 4200, are both reviewed as part of your application for admission to Teacher Education in Art Education.
